Director's Notes:

The Ladies' Doubles started right on time (11am) with 20 players (50%) of the qualified players. When it was over, we had 2 very excited young ladies, Shanda Kozak & Mooody Davis, who WON THEIR FIRST DARTISTRY TOURNAMENT. They won the winner's bracket starting with Sara Lloyd & Tracie Crowe, then Karen Williams & Tina Schultz, and finally Raylene Gleghorn & Suszi Hall in 3 games, in the finals they had to fend off Gloria Albright (their close friend) & Roni Doggett who worked their way back through the losers' bracket past Lori Burgett & Rebecca Ketchel, Lisa Brinson & Pam Dzendolet, and eventually got their for payback against Suszi Hall & Raylene Gleghorn, who knocked them into the Loser's Bracket. Third Place went to Raylene & Suszi after a very close grudge match for third. We finished at 3:15pm with the ladies' singles tourney already started..

The Men's Doubles really surprised me with 50 players. COOL! There was a wide range of talent in this tourney, but a couple of very strong teams. The eventual winners were Jason Dutton & Ernesto Castenhiera. They were almost knocked into the Loser's Bracket in the

Every one of these 22 ladies were in a competitive spirit and Intimidation didn't seem to enter the tournament. Lots of good darts were thrown. Almost every match was close and could have gone either way. The eventual winner was Roni Doggett over Lori Burgett (new girl in town). Lori made it to the finals after initially losing to Cindy McGaughey (our 3rd place winner) in the first round, but working back past Suzanne Clayton, then Tina Schultz (her roommate), Cathy Davidson, Joan Bullard, Pam Dzendolet and eventually paying back Cindy in another grudge match. Roni was 'really on' making her way to 1st place past Raylene Gleghorn, Camille Childers, Tina Schultz, Pam Dzendolet, Cindy McGaughey and eventually Lori. Ladies you threw fantastic darts. Thanks for 'strutting your stuff' for us all 2 see.

The **MENS Singles** actually had 43 players *(the most yet- well done guys) (109 men qualified)*. The field consisted of young excited and new talent to experienced seasoned players. Everyone threw excellent darts while the eventual winners threw EXCEPTIONAL darts. The finals were Mike Davidson & Ernesto Castenhiera. Mike had to work his past players like Eric Pope, Kirk Dzendolet, and Ernesto to wait in the winners' bracket for Ernesto to face him, again. Ernesto was constantly challenged by players like Jeff Allsop and Jason Dutton (*twice*) on his way back to win his grudge match against Mike Davidson. Thanks to all of the men who stepped up to make this tourney full and fun. Hopefully,

next season more men will join the Singles. If they do, I'm sure there will be a few surprises.

Finally, the **Modified Blind-Draw** unlike last season's 'Rated Draw' did have a few very powerful teams, yet none of them had an easy road through the brackets. This tourney started at 8:30pm with 72 players, yet still ended by 1:45am. Wasn't sure it could be done that quickly, but everyone helped score and GREAT DARTS were thrown all night.

The eventual winners were Bobby Childers & Mike Kasper winning in 3 games over Kevin Knox (first season) & Eric Pope in the finals. Bobby & Kasper's 'road to the finals' went through Roni Doggett & Mike Davidson, then Sara Lloyd & Harvey Tijerina, Elaine McDade & Scooter Heath, Pito & Ernesto, and finally Kevin & Eric (twice) to win the tournament. Eric & Kevin had to go through Mooody Davis & Ben Hendon, Gloria Albright & Kirk Dzendolet, Shanda Kozak & Mike Patin, then Kay Duncan & Mike Lohman, eventually leaving Pito & Ernesto with 3rd and finally winning 2nd place.

I believe one of the most EXCITING Parts of this days events was the fact that SO MANY players had EARNED "**Participation Reward Credits**" allowing them to play in some of the tournaments at a discounted *(prepaid)* rate. There were a few players that didn't have to pay any entry fees at all because they had played 40 times or more during the qualifying season. This program will continue along with some other special programs allowing out-of-city players a chance to qualify and join us at this NEXT DARTISTRY.

The "Participation Reward Program" is used to REWARD the Players who play the most during any season. For every tournament played <u>over the INITIAL 10 tourneys</u> needed to qualify for the season-end Dartistry Championships, a player earns \$1 prepaid credit toward their entry fees at this event. Play 40 times and your entry fees are ALL paid. Of course you still have to "place in the money" at least once, but that's easy. You can do it.!

All in all it was a Fun tournament with fantastic competition, fabulous pay-outs, and phenomenal darts thrown. Thanks everyone for playing, score keeping, and making this day so much FUN for ALL!.
