There were a total of 1,776 "Participation Reward Credits" earned throughout last season. With 1,336 of them used.

This season we had SEVEN (7) TOURNAMENTS held over 3 days. All were Double Elimination tourneys - totaling over \$11,090 total payout during the event.

SATURDAY – The TWO tournaments on this day were BOTH RATED Tourneys Throughout the six month qualifying season prior to this Dartistry, the players earned a 'Play/Ratio' (tourneys played vs. tourneys they "placed in the money"). Ex. Play 10 times & placed 3 times = a 33.33% ratio. This ratio then determined which division they were placed in for each separate rated tournament.

There were two different divisions or groups in the Rated Draw with the TOP HALF (best ratios) of all the registered players drawing a partner from the BOTTOM HALF (lowest ratios). Here are the results of this first rated tourney.

The Rated Singles, below, was ONE TOURNAMENT broken down into THREE SEPARATE & equal DIVISIONS. This tourney was based on PLAY/RATIOS earned throughout the season and NOT SEX. Women played against Men. The TOP 1/3 of the players (best P/P ratio) ended up in 'Division-A'. The 1/3 of the participating players in the middle of the P/P ratio were in 'Division-B' and 1/3 of the players with the lowest P/P ratio ended up in 'Division-C'. Once this initial separation was accomplished all the women were given a chance to move down ONE division (not many of them chose to do so) and everyone was given a chance to move UP one division in order to play a different format.

Division A – Format = 3 of 5 in winners / Chicago style 2 of 3 in losers

Division B – Format = Chicago Style 2 of 3 winners/ 1 game BC in losers

Division C – Format = 2 of 3 all 501 SS/DO / 1 game 501 in losers.

All divisions ended up finishing within 30 minutes of each other.

THIS WAS AN ALL CASH CHALKER PRIZE WEEKEND

Once a winning ticket was pulled the player rolled either 1 or 2 dice to determine how much MONEY they WON. On Friday night we started out pulling a ticket every ½ hour and ended up just paying the Scorekeeper for the LAST 5 or 6 matches \$5.

FRIDAY NIGHT'S GRAND CHALKER PRIZE of \$50 went to Corey Harris

On Saturday we had at least ONE Winner every hour and again the last 6 matches were automatic \$5 winners.

SATURDAY NIGHT'S GRAND CHALKER PRIZE of \$50 went to Danny Mitchell

On Sunday it was the same as on Saturday with a winner an hour rolling ONE Die. The last 6 matches were automatic \$5 winners.

SUNDAY NIGHT'S GRAND CHALKER PRIZE of \$50 went to Nassar Alhamdani

This was the first time we ever USED **ALL CASH** as the Chalker/Scorekeeper prizes. It sure was simpler from a Director's point of view and will definitely be done again at sometime or another. We always try to have FUN and Exciting Prizes to win for these events in order to provide a means to REWARD those players who keep score the most, while keeping an element of LUCK (cause Chalking is still a necessity) involved, too.

## Director's Notes:

This 10th DFW Dartistry was a TEST TO STRETCH this seasonal EVENT to a \$10,000+ total PAYOUT WEEKED. We actually reached an exciting \$9,000 Guaranteed payout in the actual tourneys with a TOTAL of OVER \$11,090 when we include the Side Pots and Chalker Prizes.

Each tourney started ON TIME and actually ended approximately at my estimated finishing time. The RATED SINLGES seemed to take quite a long time (especially in the beginning and early stages of the tourney), but with 89 players and ONLY 12 boards available to play on, I felt we did OK. We still managed to get all THREE tourneys done before 1:30 am. Not everyone seemed happy with the process, however. Well, come on gang, this was the first time we tried it. It took a little longer to organize the tourney and get the DIVISIONS determined and we didn't have enough boards to play everyone at once. (This is an area to work on –ideas are being submitted already).

I was really disappointed with SUNDAY'S TURNOUT, as it only brought in HALF AS MANY players for the Men's & Ladies Doubles & Singles as we had LAST Season. My directors and I have initially determined this was because almost NONE of the BOTTOM HALF of the Play/Place ratio players showed up on Sunday. Most of them must have decided they couldn't effectively compete against most of the players that would show up on Sunday. Even though, last season a good majority of them DID come out to compete in these events on Saturday. Maybe because it was on Saturday last year. Anyway, this was a really disappointing turn-out and will definitely affect next season's DARTISTRY FORMAT for the weekend. Changes will be made.

All in all it was a Fun tournament with fantastic competition, fabulous pay-outs, and phenomenal darts thrown. Thanks everyone for playing, score keeping, and making this weekend so much FUN for ALL!

This season, as every season, Drinks' STAFF rearranged their club in order to accommodate 4 extra 'Dart Standards' (curtesy of the DDA & the MDA) and made room for extra seating by moving out their pool tables. Because of this, we had no problems with getting the 4 tourneys started and completed on time AND we had extra PRACTICE boards throughout the weekend.

This was the first DARTISTRY EVENT in which the NEW OWNERS, Paulette Herschner & Joe Davis were in charge. I felt they did an AWESOME job preparing the club and arranging for help to insure WE had a great time. Please thank Paulette, Joe and their WHOLE STAFF, (especially Gene Bullard & Joe for getting and setting up the dart standards) for making this weekend work and be so enjoyable. The bartenders and wait staff worked their buns off. Hopefully, y'all took care of them with well earned and sizable tips.
