The THREE tournaments on this day were the RATED SINGLES Tourney and the MEN'S \& LADIES' Blind-Draw tourneys.

For the RATED SINGLES \& The RATED DRAW- Throughout the six month qualifying season prior to this Dartistry, the players earned a 'Play/Ratio' (tourneys played vs. tourneys they "placed in the money"). Ex. Play 10 times \& placed 3 times $=$ a $33.33 \%$ ratio. This ratio then determined which division they were placed in for each separate rated tournament.

The Rated Singles, below, was ONE TOURNAMENT broken down into THREE SEPARATE \& equal DIVISIONS. This tourney was based on PLAY/RATIOS earned throughout the season and NOT SEX. Women played against Men. The TOP $1 / 3$ of the players (best P/P ratio) ended up in 'Division- A'. The $1 / 3$ of the participating players in the middle of the $\mathrm{P} / \mathrm{P}$ ratio were in 'Division-B' and $1 / 3$ of the players with the lowest $P / P$ ratio ended up in 'Division-C'. Once this initial separation was accomplished all the women were given a chance to move down ONE division (not many of them chose to do so) and everyone was given a chance to move UP one division in order to play a different format.

Division A - Format $=3$ of 5 in winners / Chicago style 2 of 3 in losers
Division B - Format = Chicago Style 2 of 3 winners/ same in the losers bracket. Plenty of time.
Division C - Format $=2$ of 3 all 501 SS/DO / same in the losers bracket. Plenty of time.
All divisions ended up finishing within 30 minutes of each other.

## Director's Notes:

## This 11th DFW Dartistry was a TEST TO STRETCH this

 seasonal EVENT to a $\$ 11,000+$ total PAYOUT WEEKED. . I based the guarantee on the same number that showed up last season, figuring with a location with plenty of parking, higher ceilings, and food service, more players would show up. HOWEVER, we ended 52 players under the estimates I used. GO FIGURE! most everyone must like a crowed smoky place with cars being towed off because they parked in designated spaces. DUH. I don't understand it. Even though we were under the expectations, PSP paid out the Guaranteed Funds. TOTAL PAID OUT FUNDS actually reached an exciting \$9,300 Guaranteed payout in the actual tourneys with a TOTAL of OVER $\$ 11,708$ when we include the Side Pots and Chalker Prizes.With less than the anticipated players in most of the tourneys we played TWO of THREE in the losers brackets which did cause us to run about an hour late for the SECOND \& THIRD

EVENTS each day. Yet, we still finished before closing on Sat \& Sunday. Friday night we were there till around $2: 45 \mathrm{am}$.

The Billiard Den laid out very nice with plenty of room to move. After we put up SIX STANDARDS (PSP's very own - built this season), there were actually 4 separate throwing areas with spectator space and lots of table room. I LOVED IT. I liked being able to move around without bumping into someone's face especially behind the Director's area which was set off in the corner, but still in a great position to oversee the whole EVENT. WE WILL BE HOLDING NEXT SEASON'S DARTISTRY HERE, AGAIN.

There were definitely some problems in the area of Service. There were issues related to a new \& inexperienced club, waitresses, bartenders, and owners that need to be worked on and resolved for the next Dartistry. We actually wore out 2 of their servers who left sick early, leaving us with one or two before the night was over. With them having to take on the work of four (billiard players, also), the service to the Dart Players went to $\mathrm{H}^{* * *}$. I'm sure each of you have some complaints relating to service or whatever. But, I sincerely hope y'all get over it before April of 2008. I'm giving them another chance. Please do the same thing.

Even with the new format or schedule of tournaments this season, we still didn't have many more players on Sunday than last season. And Saturday was a lot less, especially for the RATED SINGLES. We had only 64 against 90 last time. Yes, there was a tourney at Volcanos that took away about 10 to 15 of the better players, however, I was surprised that not as many of the lower ranked players showed up for this tourney. Since, they only had to play against the same skill level. I would have thought with 214 qualified players we would have had around $50 \%$ turnout???????????????? Oh well.

This next season OVERALL PAYOUT WILL BE NOT BE A GUARANTEED PAYOUT. IT WILL BE BASED ON PARTICIPATION with a minimum of the number of players who turned out this time. I'm not taking a $\$ 1,000$ bath, again. With that kind of bath, it should be oriental in nature, and give plenty of satisfaction if you know what I mean.

All in all it was a Fun tournament with fantastic competition, fabulous pay-outs, and phenomenal darts thrown. Thanks everyone for playing, score keeping, and making this weekend so much FUN for ALL!.

This was the first DARTISTRY EVENT at The Billiard Den and I believe the NEXT ONE will run smoother and the service will be well improved. I wish to thank Larry, Marcy, \& Sean Rothberg, the owners, for their LONG HOURS during the whole week; as they also had the Richardson Corporate Challenge with $100+$ people the 3 days prior to our event. I know they were exhausted and definitely deserve your applause holding it together especially with so many of their staff leaving early each day.

A special thanks goes to my co-directors (in NO particular order), Amy Ainsworth, Raylene Gleghorn, Candace Neal, my wife Sara, our newest director, Shannon Whyte, and the occasional help from Ernesto, Danny Mitchell, Chris Helms, \& Donna Gutierez (selling shirts). The TEAM did a great JOB allowing each of us directors to enjoy playing in the tourneys, also. Thanks everyone.

As for SHIRTS, they won't be happening Next season. I only had 30 made for sale, still have 5 of them left. We did have 10 ordered and it will be at least 2 weeks to get those filled. Maybe when I design a new LOGO, it will be time, again.
