There were a total of 918 "Participation Reward Credits" earned throughout last season. You can tell from this stat that the overall participation this season was down by 30% from last year with 1218 earned. Which is the MAIN reason the following FORMAT and PAYOUT Structure was chosen.

THIS WAS THE **FIRST SEASON** WITH ZERO ENTRY FEES for QUALIFIED players. Plus, we again allowed players to be ELIGIBLE even though NOT Qualified (cost to them was only \$10 per tourney).

This season we had THREE (3) TOURNAMENTS held on Saturday, April 24th. Upon popular request we had a Men's Blind-Draw, a Ladies' Blind-Draw, and a Modified Blind-Draw. All

were Double Elimination totaling \$3,000 total payout during the event. Also, we had ONE Dartistry Warm-Up Tournament on Friday Night @ The Billiard Den with an Extra \$200 added on top of the clubs' normal \$5 pp Add.

REWARD CREDIT 'RAFFLE' program

After I had introduced the FREE Entry program, many players mentioned that allowing NONqualified players to enter the Dartistry (even though they had to pay \$10 per tourney) seemed unfair to those players who had earned REWARD CREDITS for supporting the Circuit more than 10 times. This would mean more of their money could be won by others who didn't support the Circuit as much. Their point was well accepted; therefore in order to REWARD those players who supported the Circuit more than 10 times and give them an exciting opportunity to be ADDITIONALLY REWARDED for their efforts, I came up with this plan.

EACH REWARD CREDIT EARNED – Gave them ONE CHANCE TO WIN A PORTION OF THE ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEES added to each tourney by those players who had NOT 'QUALIFIED'. I had made up 918 small slips of paper with a player's name on it for every Reward Credit they earned, placed them in a JAR and then drew out WINNERS for all the extra money paid to play by the 'Eligible' players. Each person won \$20 every time their name was drawn. Their chances to win were based on how many times they played during the season. Cool Huh? Winners were:

Director's Notes:

Probably a combination of a few things – like - FREE ENTRY FEES for qualified players; arranging for 'Eligible' players; it was not Nascar weekend; it was 2 weeks after Superdarts; lots of players came out to practice for League Playoffs; with NO entry fees it meant players could enjoy the day and have money to spend on other things; many marginally skilled played felt they would not be donating another \$30+ to the pots and hoped they might draw a good player for a chance to win a portion of the Prize Money; and of course - Just to have a GOOD time. Any other ideas?

This weekend kicked off with a Great Friday Night Warm-up Tourney. 40 players all getting in some practice and laughs before the BIG DAY on Saturday. It was wonderful to see THREE MIXED teams finish the night in 1st to 3rd. I love it when that happens; makes the Modified Draw 'STRUT it's STUFF'.

This was the FIRST SEASON where we had FREE ENTRY FEES for qualified players. It took me long enough to put my ego aside and NOT care whether The Dartistry was a HUGE Payout event. I finally realized that it's here just for everyone to have a good time, especially those players who supported the Circuit all season long. I have attempted to make it worth everyone's time to continuously support the Circuit throughout the season, so we can have these season-end events. The REWARD CREDIT program was one such concept – however, with the advent of FREE ENTRY FEES those players lose the benefit that program gave them. So, in order to still make it worth everyone's time, I started the 'Raffle' program. See above for details.

I certainly believe finally reaching the point where it doesn't cost people a lot of ADDitional monies to play in this event is a turning point toward larger and more successful Dartistries and increased qualification stats. At least, I certainly hope so.

I just got tired of digging into so many friends pocket books, just so we can have LARGE Payouts at the Dartistry or more tournaments. The economic times don't warrant doing that and FREE ENTRY FEES certainly make my soul feel better.

To see so many people ENJOY a DAY of playing DARTS, whether they won or lost, made the whole season worthwhile. When I see smiles on everyone's faces after 12 hours of throwing and hear constant laughter all day, I feel I did something right. THEREFORE, we will KEEP this FREE ENTRY System in place for this 17th DFW Dartistry Season which runs from April 1st, 2010 until September 30th, 2010.
