I like it as it makes it more affordable for those couples who have to have babysitters and/or extra costs just to come and play. So, we will continue with this format once again this next 21st Dartistry Season, too.

This season we had a **MEN'S BLIND-DRAW TOURNAMENT** held on Saturday, April 21st which began at 1:00 pm with **36 players.** Plus, we had a **LADIES' BLIND-DRAW**, also on Sat which began at 1:30 pm with **18**

players. Both were followed by a **HUGE MODIFIED BLIND-DRAW** that began at 7:00 pm with 54 players.
