I like it, especially since the economy hasn't recovered fully and it makes easier on everyone wallets; and it makes it more affordable for those couples who have to have babysitters and/or extra costs just to come and play. So, we will continue with this format once again this next 23rd Dartistry Season, too.

We had a **MEN'S BLIND-DRAW TOURNAMENT** held on Saturday, April 20th which began at 1:00 pm with **40 players.** Plus, we also had a **LADIES' BLIND-DRAW**, on Sat which began at 1:30 pm with **18 players.** Both were followed by a
